Events

We will be running 5 club trials in 2026 (this does not include the summer series)

Name	Date	Routes
Valentine	18 th January	Hard, 50/50, Middle and Easy
Stonebridge	1 st March	Hard, 50/50 and Middle
Cuckoo	12 th April	Hard, 50/50, Middle and Easy
Ken Wood	13 th September	Hard, 50/50, Middle and Easy
Chris Wood	1st November	Hard, 50/50 and Middle

Valid entry

To score points in the club championship you must be a member of the Cambridge Matchless Motorcycle Club.

You must also select Cambridge Matchless as the club you are riding for when entering the event on Sport:80. If you can not select it correctly please contact the ACU so they can investigate and fix it, this only takes a couple of minutes.

Points

Points will be awarded to the top ten finishers in each class, 1st place = 10 points, 2nd place = 9 points, all the way down to 10th place = 1 point.

You can change which class you ride during the year and providing you are in the top ten you will score points in any class.

Championship placing

Expert, Expert B, Intermediate, Clubman, Novice and Twinshock competitors have five rounds in total, so four rounds will count with the lowest score discounted if you scored in all five rounds

Sportsman competitors only have three rounds so all will count

Results

A results table will be published after each event

Awards

Awards are based on the number of qualifiers for each class

1-4 qualifiers First place only

5-9 qualifiers First and second place

10+ qualifiers First, second and third

Guidance on Routes and Classes

Routes

Events have the following routes:

- Hard - This is the hardest route at the event
- 50/50 - Half of the sections from the Hard route and half from the middle route
- Middle - In between the hardest and easiest route
- Easy - The easiest route at the event

Note – the Stonebridge and Chris Wood trial do not have an Easy route

Classes

Events have the following classes

- Expert - Rides the Hard route (aimed at the best of the best 😊)
- Expert B - Rides the 50/50 route (aimed at Experts dropping down a route)
- Intermediate - Rides the 50/50 route (aimed at Clubman/Novice going up a route)
- Clubman - Rides the middle route (aimed at Novices not going up a route or Expert B, Intermediate dropping down a route)
- Novice - Rides the middle route (aimed at Sportsman going up a route)
- Twinshock - Rides the middle route (for competitors with twinshocks only but like a challenge)
- Sportsman - Rides the easy route (aimed at beginners, fun riders, any bike)
- Youths - Can chose which route they want ride but must notify the secretary when entering

Anyone new to the club and not sure which class to ride then please contact me or any other committee member for advice.
